

# Student Outcome Rates

## DiGrigoli School of Cosmetology

In order to enable prospective students to make an informed decision in selecting DiGrigoli School of Cosmetology for their education, we are required by our accrediting agency to provide the following information for the year ending December **2017**:

Completion Rate <sup>1</sup> :	<b>66%</b>	Students that completed the course within the contracted term length
Licensure Rate:	<b>91%</b>	Graduates that took the State Board licensure examination, passed both portions of the exam and received a license
Job Placement Rate <sup>2</sup> :	<b>65%</b>	Graduates that reported employment in a cosmetology related industry/profession

*NOTE: The minimum standards for outcomes, as defined by the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences (NACCAS), are: Completion – 50%, Licensure – 70%, and Placement – 60%*

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<sup>1</sup> Students that did not complete the program within the contracted term length either a) dropped the course and terminated their contract for instruction, or b) required a contract extension due to a leave of absence from the program.

<sup>2</sup> In determining job placement rates, DiGrigoli School of Cosmetology can only include graduates for whom we were able to confirm employment within the cosmetology field. Our accrediting agency requires us to include in this rating graduates who have not yet taken or passed the licensure exam, even though the Commonwealth of Massachusetts prohibits the employment of unlicensed individuals in professional salons.

Graduates must be considered eligible for placement unless they meet one of the following five criteria:

1. Graduate is deceased
2. Graduate is permanently disabled
3. Graduate is deployed for military service/duty
4. Graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment
5. Graduate is continuing their education at an institution under the same ownership
